A JAEGER THOUGHT TO BE A POMARINE WAS REPORTED AT BITTER LAKE NWR 9/18-23 (VM ET AL.); DETAILS INCLUDE IT BEING HAWK-LIKE IN FLIGHT, GULL-LIKE IN THE WATER, THE SIZE OF CASPIAN TERNS NEARBY, AND COLOR BROWN EXCEPT FOR LARGE WHITE WING PATCH AND BARRED FLANKS AND CRISSUM.
