The New Mexico Ornithological Society (NMOS) will hold its 53rd Annual Meeting on Saturday, 11 April 2015, at the Holiday Inn in Roswell. This meeting will include an NMOS business meeting, an NMOS general science session, and an evening banquet and keynote speaker. The keynote speaker will be Dr. Warren C. Conway, Bricker Endowed Chair in Wildlife Management from Texas Tech University, and his talk with be entitled "**Snowy plovers and associated nesting habitats in the Southern High Plains: trends and conservation concerns**". Meeting participants are encouraged to stay on site at the Holiday Inn, which has established a special discounted room rate for NMOS meeting attendees.

NMOS is coordinating with the United Field Ornithologists of Roswell (UFO-R) to host an organized, guided field trip (no charge) on Sunday morning following the meeting.
