New Mexico Ornithological Society 2097 Camino Lado Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501 The highlights of the summer certainly have to include the discovery of first New Mexico nests of Olivaceous Cormorant, Cattle Egret, and Little Blue Heron at Elephant Butte Lake, further proof that the "Narrows" there is the most important waterbird breeding area in the state. Besides the nests of these species were hundreds of those of Double-crested Cormorants, Snowy Egret, and Black-crowned Night Heron, plus several of Common Egrets. Although this is a manmade habitat, it might be regarded as a replacement for the natural sloughs and oxbows that existed on the Rio Grande before humans began to "reclaim" it. This status, plus the fact that waterbirds readily accept it for breeding purposes, certainly calls for its being conserved for wildlife to every extent possible.

The summer of 1975 also yielded records of several Common Snipe and a Fox Sparrow in the northern mountain areas, and at least the former seem to be a good possibility of having been breeders. lushness of prairie grasses and forbs--including one of the best wildflower displays in years in the east--gave promise for a good breeding year for meadowlarks, Cassin's Sparrows, and Lark Buntings, and some hope also existed that Dickcissels might summer in the northeast and Bobolinks in the Chama Valley. Neither of the latter species materialized, and Lark Buntings were disappointingly scarce; however, a pair was found at a nest for perhaps the first breeding record in the northwest. Eastern and Western Meadowlarks showed extensive overlap this summer, as the latter moved (or stayed) southward in numbers well into the central-western and southeastern parts of the state. It may be that in years of lusher vegetation there is "room" for Westerns to summer among Easterns in grasslands in the south; otherwise Westerns seem mainly to occupy more mesic sites in that area, e.g. irrigated fields. Cassin's Sparrows were reported during early summer only from the Pecos Valley eastward and in the Jornada Experimental Range, but we suspect that they were also present at least locally further southwest as well.

Only five Least Terns summered at Bitter Lake N. W. R., and no nests were found. This species may be a candidate for the endangered list in New Mexico, and the race to which our population apparently belongs (i.e., the interior Least Tern, Sterna albifrons athalassos) is under national scrunity in view of the decline in its numbers.

Unusual summer vagrants including a Common Loon in Catron Co., White-tailed Kite (photographed for first confirmed occurrence in New Mexico) in Chaves Co., a flock of California Gulls (photographed) in Rio Arriba Co., an apparent Blue-throated Hummingbird in Los Alamos Co., a late Hooded Warbler (plus more common birds) in Roosevelt Co., and a possibly breeding Baltimore (Northern) Oriole in Union Co.

The big event of the autumn was the anxiously awaited arrival of the juvenile Whooping Cranes raised in Idaho by foster-parent Sandhill Cranes known to winter in the Rio Grande Valley. In October and November four of the six Whoopers known to have reached the flying stage arrived in the state, with one each settling in at Los Lunas and Bernardo State Game Refuge and two at Bosque del Apache N.W.R. Other notable autumn records were of at least six different Common Loons over the state, a Wood Stork, two Anna Hummingbirds, and single Parula and Cape May Warblers in Grant Co., two Black Scoters (one collected for first verified state record), an apparent Groove-billed Ani (photographed), and a Tennessee Warbler in Socorro Co., two Surf Scoters and a Lapland Longspur (all photographed), plus an apparent Red Phalarope in Hidalgo Co., a Red Knot, a possible Hudsonian Godwit, and a Hooded Warbler in Chaves Co., a Thayer Gull (second state specimen and record) in Dona Ana Co., a Sabine Gull in San Juan Co., and a Chestnut-sided Warbler in Torrance Co. In addition to the Lapland Longspur in Hidalgo Co., many Chestnut-collars and several McCown's were also netted there in November.

Besides unusual birds, a major thing to report was that humming-bird numbers at feeders were generally down. Several observers commented on this, especially in regard to Rufous Hummers. However, it would appear that the scarcity was more apparent than real, as counts in the Sacramento Mts. yielded good numbers in suitable habitats. It seems likely that an abundance of wildflowers lured hummers away from feeders and that the birds could not really be considered to have declined in numbers from past years.
