FROM THE EDITORS:

Noteworthy winter records for the reporting period include sightings of several species rarely seen in the state. These included a Red-necked Grebe near Loving, a Brown Pelican near Cliff, a Harlequin Duck at Bitter Lake National Wildlife Refuge, Red-breasted Mergansers reported from three different localities, two Harris Hawks near Hatch, a Caracara near Columbus, Sprague Pipits near Rodeo and at Percha Dam State Park, a Hutton Vireo at Rodeo, and a Solitary Vireo near Cliff. Unusual wintering records included two Rivoli Hummingbirds near Albuquerque, and an immature male Anna Hummingbird at Las Cruces. In addition, several Cassin Sparrows were reported near Rodeo during January and February.

Spring records included the discovery of a male Coppery-tailed Trogon in the Animas Mountains, a White-winged Crossbill at Sandia Crest near Albuquerque, and the state's first Roseate Tern was photographed near Roswell. Additional noteworthy spring records included a Louisiana Heron at Roswell, a Wood Thrush at Las Vegas, a Le Conte Sparrow in southern Dona Ana County, and a Golden-crowned Sparrow near Silver City.

COMMON LOON

con/rec--1 at Las Cruces 12/17 (WP).

RED-NECKED GREBE

uns/rec--1 unverified with fair details near Loving 12/30 (LW, RW). Details include "much larger than a Ruddy Duck, long neck (longer than Eared Grebe) and basically gray with fairly long thin bill."

EARED GREBE

win/rec--1 near Lordsburg 1/14 (RF), and 2-6 reported at Holloman L. 1/19-28 (LM+).

WHITE PELICAN

con/rec--4 near Cochiti L. 5/7 (ML).

BROWN PELICAN

uns/rec--1 south of Evans L. near the Gila River Bird Sanctuary 2/13 (AG). Details include "large dark bird with large bill and gular pouch, light head, primaries seemed darker than body and wings."

DOUBLE-CRESTED CORMORANT

con/rec--singles at Evans L. 5/6 and at Las Cruces 4/21 (BZ,KZ).

OLIVACEOUS CORMORANT

con/rec--1 at Caballo L. 2/4 (KZ) and 1 on the Gila River near Cliff 5/6 (K. Jackson, MZ).

GREAT BLUE HERON

con/rec--only 1 pair present at the nest colony near Watrous 4/16 and 5/27 (WH).

GREEN HERON

con/rec--4 near Espanola 5/13 (WS), 1 at Holloman L. 4/22 (LM) and 5/6 (BZ,KZ); 1 wintered at the Gila Hot Springs (RF).

LITTLE BLUE HERON

con/rec--1 near Socorro 4/2 (PB), 1 at the Bosque del Apache NWR 12/3 (RT), and 1 near Alamogordo 4/29 and 2 on 5/16 (K. Haemket).

CATTLE EGRET

con/rec--7-8 at Nutria L. 5/1 (Terry Merkel), 1 near Socorro 4/2 (PB) and there 4/9 (AT), 1 at the Bosque del Apache NWR 12/3 (RT), and a possible sighting of 16 near Albuquerque in April (fide JP).

SNOWY EGRET

win/rec--1 at Avalon-McMillan L. 12/28 (JC+).

LOUISIANA HERON

uns/rec--1 at Bitter Lake NWR - said to have been photographed 5/8-9 (JC+).

WHISTLING SWAN

con/rec--1 below Navajo L. photographed 12/27 and last seen 1/14 (AN), an immature at Alameda 12/23-27 (JP), 1 at Roswell 12/17 (JC), and 1-2 near Alamogordo 1/15-2/5 (LM+).

WHITE-FRONTED GOOSE

con/rec--1 at Roswell 12/17 (JC) and 1 at Sunland Park 1/29 (KZ).

ROSS GOOSE

con/rec--1 at Clayton 12/29-1/6 (AK,WC), 260-500 at Bosque del Apache NWR 12/17 and 12/28 (JC+, CH+), and 6 at Loving 12/30 (SW+).

CINNAMON TEAL

uns/rec--150 at Bitter Lake NWR 12/17 (JC+).

WOOD DUCK

win/rec--1 drake at Fruitland 1/4-14 (AN), a drake wintered at the Gila Hot Springs (RF), and 1 was reported near Avalon-McMillan L. 12/28 (JC+).

HARLEQUIN DUCK

uns/rec--a male was photographed at Bitter Lake NWR in mid-December and remained until 1/6 (DB).

HOODED MERGANSER

con/rec--an unspecified number at Fruitland 1/4-14 (AN), a female at the Bosque del Apache NWR 12/28 (CH), and 1 at Las Cruces 12/17 (WP+).

RED-BREASTED MERGANSER

con/rec--1 at Caballo L. 1/5 (JH), 3 at Holloman L. 4/22 (LM+), 2 at Evans L. 12/17 (DZ,MZ), and 37 at Harroun L. 3/1 (JH,GS).

Kite sp.

uns/rec--a probable Mississippi Kite seen near Cliff 5/7 (Ann & Dustin Hunt).

GOSHAWK

con/rec--1 near Alameda 2/23 (JP).

ZONE-TAILED HAWK

con/rec--1 at Pleasanton 3/29 (JH+).

HARRIS HAWK

uns/rec--2 reported just N. of Hatch 1/26 (SC).

GOLDEN EAGLE

br/rec--the number of occupied nests in Grant County was lower than normal (RF).

BALD EAGLE

con/rec--aerial and ground surveys in the 1977-78 winter season yielded 358 for the period, with most in the northern regions and in the Gila National Forest area (JH+); 1 near Glenwood 4/22 was late (BC,DM).

CARACARA

uns/rec--1 reported without details E. of Columbus 12/3 (BR).

PRAIRIE FALCON

br/rec--an eyrie in the Cook's Range 4/25 (JH).

MERLIN

con/rec--15 birds reported by numerous observers; most records from the central and northern portions of the state.

GAMBEL QUAIL

uns/rec--a male at Las Vegas 3/19-4/7 (WH) was undoubtedly an escaped or released bird (JH).

CHUKAR

con/rec--18 at Farmington 12/17 and 4 there 5/13 (AN).

WHOOPIING CRANE

con/rec--as of mid-December, 5 were present in the Socorro area and 1 was near Hatch; the latter was "corny", the bird that was present near Las Vegas from November to December 5 (fide Jack Woody). Migration began as expected in February, 3 were seen in flight N. of Albuquerque 2/26 (JDu+).

SANDHILL CRANE

con/rec--229 near Cliff 12/17 (RF+).

VIRGINIA RAIL

win/rec--1 at Farmington 12/17 (AN), 1 near Espanola 12/26 (BL), and 1 at Carlsbad Caverns NP 12/26 (RW).

SORA

win/rec--1 at Farmington 12/17 (AN).

MOUNTAIN PLOVER

br/rec--4 at Santo Domingo 3/21 (JH) where on 5/31 there were several adults and 3 chicks (JDu). uns/rec--small numbers near Datil 3/28-4/20 (AT), where virtually unreported in recent years.

UPLAND SANDPIPER

uns/rec--3 along I-40 E. of Tucumcari 4/10 (KZ).

SPOTTED SANDPIPER

win/rec--22 near Cliff 12/17 (RF+) was a high number; sp/rec--2-3 at Silvas Tank in the Sierra de las Uvas 5/12, 18 (JD).

LESSER YELLOWLEGS

win/rec--1 at Bitter Lakes NWR 12/17 (JC+) and 7 in the Carlsbad area 12/30 (SW+).

RED KNOT

uns/rec--6 reported with fair details from Holloman L. 4/20 (LM+) and 1-2 reported without details W. of Hatch during the reporting period (Linda Seibert).

LONG-BILLED CURLEW

con/rec--1 W. of Magdalena 5/31 (JH).

MARbled GODWIT

sp/rec--2 near Redrock 5/6 (RF+).

PHALAROPE sp.

uns/rec--3 reported at Bitter Lake NWR 12/17 (JC+), details too sketchy to confirm the species.

HERRING GULL

uns/rec--1 near Des Moines 12/7 (JH) and 1 near Cliff 5/6 (RF+).

ROSEATE TERN

uns/rec--1 photographed W. of Roswell 5/1 (Phelps White), and verified by K.C. Parker and H. Hays for the first New Mexico record; also two reported at Bitter Lake NWR 4/21 (V.L. Grover).

RINGED TURTLE DOVE

uns/rec--1 at Rattlesnake Springs 5/6 (RW); also recorded in previous years in the Carlsbad area.

WHITE-WINGED DOVE

win/rec--1 in the Peloncillo Mts. 1/1 (RS+); con/rec--5 at Alamogordo 3/14 (LM).

GROUND DOVE

con/rec--3 at Redrock 4/29 and 4 at Cliff 5/6 (RF+), and 1 near Loving 12/30 (SW+).

FLAMMULATED OWL

uns/rec--1 reportedly heard at Cottonwood Gulch 3/7,11 (AM) was extremely early.

PYGMY OWL

win/rec--1 at Farmington 12/17 (AN). Sp/rec--1 at El Morro 3/7 (AM), and 2-3 observed 3/24 near Snow L. for an extended period, during which time mating was observed (JD).

SAW-WHET OWL

con/rec--1 seen and heard at Cottonwood Gulch 3/7,11 (AM).

WHIP-POR-WILL

con/rec--1 heard in the Cook's Range 4/23 (JH).

HUMMINGBIRD sp.

uns/rec--an all green hummingbird was seen 1/16 in Alamogordo (LM+), it was probably an Anna Hummingbird.

BLACK-CHINNED HUMMINGBIRD

sp/arr--present at Glenwood 3/25 (BM) and at Farmington by 4/9 (AN).

COSTA HUMMINGBIRD

con/rec--3 adult males and 2 immature birds were banded 5/6-7 in Guadalupe Canyon (WB). A careful census showed that at least 6 adult males, an immature male, and 2 immature birds were present in the New Mexico portion of the canyon; an extended search in the Arizona portion of the canyon located only 1 additional bird.

ANNA HUMMINGBIRD

uns/rec--1 wintered in Las Cruces (Tom Todson, fide WB, TM, WP).

BROAD-TAILED HUMMINGBIRD

sp/arr--present at Glenwood 3/25 (BM).

RIVOLI HUMMINGBIRD

uns/rec--an adult male and an immature bird wintered at Sandia Park (MH+).

COPPERY-TAILED TROGON

uns/rec--a calling male seen in Indian Creek, Animas Mts. 5/25 (SD) for the second specific record there.

BELTED KINGFISHER

uns/rec--1 in the N.E. portion of the Cook's Range 4/25 (JH).

COMMON FLICKER

con/rec--2 of the yellow-shafted form at Rattlesnake Springs 3/16 (WS).

RED-HEADED WOODPECKER

uns/rec--2 at Roswell 12/17 (JC).

ACORN WOODPECKER

uns/rec--1 at Blue Mesa in Dona Ana County 5/9 (JD) was out of its normal range.

HAIRY WOODPECKER

con/rec--1 at Chaco Canyon 1/5 (GS).

DOWNY WOODPECKER

con/rec--1 at Glenwood 12/30 (JH) and 2 at La Luz 12/17 (BW).

SCISSOR-TAILED FLYCATCHER

con/rec--1 near Portales 4/8 (BZ,KZ).

WIED CRESTED FLYCATCHER

con/rec--1 at Glenwood 5/9-10 and 2 there 5/20-22 (BO,DM).

EASTERN PHOEBE

con/rec--1 near Loving 12/30 (SW+).

COUES FLYCATCHER

con/rec--1 on the West Fork of the Gila River 5/6 (RF+).

VERMILION FLYCATCHER

uns/rec--a female reported at Farmington 4/8 (AN).

CAVE SWALLOW

con/rec--returned to Carlsbad Caverns NP 2/27 (RW).

PURPLE MARTIN

uns/rec--3 E. of the Sandia Mountains 5/20 (RT) and 17 near Redrock 5/6 (RF+).

BLUE JAY

uns/rec--1 at Albuquerque 4/28 (GW) and 1 at Alamogordo 12/17 (LN+); con/rec--2 at Roswell 12/17 (JC+).

BLACK-BILLED MAGPIE

con/rec--2 in Santa Fe 12/18 (RW+) and 368 at Las Vegas 12/26 (JG+).

COMMON CROW

con/rec--present at Dry Cimarron 12/8 (JH), and 500+ near Raton 3/9 (GS); uns/rec--1 at Silver City 12/31 (RF+).

WHITE-NECKED RAVEN

con/rec--2+ at the San Simon Cienaga 2/4-5 (JH,GS).

RED-BREASTED NUTHATCH

uns/rec--1 at Socorro 4/22 (PB).

PYGMY NUTHATCH

uns/rec--1 in the Cook's Range 4/23 was a local first (JH).

HOUSE WREN

con/rec--2 at Carlsbad Caverns NP 12/26 (RW+).

WINTER WREN

uns/rec--1 at Las Cruces 12/17 (TM+); con/rec--1 at Cliff 12/12 (BH).

SHORT-BILLED MARSH WREN

con/rec--1 reported without details at Bitter Lake NWR 12/17 (JC+); the species is still unvarified in New Mexico.

MOCKINGBIRD

uns/rec--51 at Carlsbad Caverns NP 12/26 (RW+); this was a very high winter number.

BROWN THRASHER

con/rec--1 near Cliff and 1 near Redrock 5/6 (RF+), 1 at Holloman L. 4/20 (LM+), 1 near Loving 12/30 (SW+), and 5 at Carlsbad Caverns NP 12/26 (RW).

BENDIRE THRASHER

uns/rec--3 at Santa Fe 12/17 (JH,RW) and 1 near Rodeo 12/30 (RS).

SAGE THRASHER

uns/rec--a very large number, 282, reported at Carlsbad Caverns NP 12/26 (RW) and 500+ reported there 3/16 (WS).

WOOD THRUSH

uns/rec--1 reported in some detail from Las Vegas 5/18 (WH).

HERMIT THRUSH

win/rec--1 at Kirtland 12/31-1/13 (CS) and 9 at Glenwood 12/30 (JH).

EASTERN BLUEBIRD

con/rec--7 at Roswell 12/17 (JC+) and 16 at Las Cruces 12/17 (WB+).

GNATCATCHER sp.

uns/rec--1 at Roswell 12/17 and 1 at Carlsbad 12/28 (JC+).

BLUE-GRAY GNATCATCHER

win/rec--6 at Las Cruces 12/17 (WP+) and 1 detailed near Carlsbad 12/28 (JC+).

GOLDEN-CROWNED KINGLET

con/rec--1 at Loving 12/30 (SW+).

SPRAGUE PIPIT

uns/rec--a bird fitting the description of this species was seen at Percha Dam SP 12/31 (TM) and 3+ were seen near Rodeo 2/4 (JH,GS).

PHAINOPEPLA
con/rec--1 at La Luz 4/26-27 (LM+).

NORTHERN SHRIKE
con/rec--32 birds reported primarily in the northern portions of the state but noteworthy was an immature at Las Cruces 12/17 (WP).

HUTTON VIREO
uns/rec--1 at Rodeo 1/1 (FS+).

GRAY VIREO
sp/rec--1 detailed at Nambu 5/13 (WS); br/rec--1-2 pair at nests, from which young fledged, in Glenwood (first county records) 4/20 through May (JH).

SOLITARY VIREO
win/rec--1 reported without details near Cliff 12/17 (DZ,MZ).

RED-EYED VIREO
uns/rec--a male was found dead along the road near White Sands NM 5/15 (JGr).

BLACK-AND-WHITE WARBLER
con/rec--1 at Farmington 3/13 (AN+).

WORM-EATING WARBLER
uns/rec--1 detailed at Rattlesnake Springs 4/17 and 5/5-6 (RW).

TENNESSEE WARBLER
sp/rec--1 at Redrock 5/6 (BZ,KZ); details include "gray cap, white eye-line, olive back, white underparts, warbler bill, singing." A single bird also reported in detail from Rattlesnake Springs 5/5 (RW).

ORANGE-CROWNED WARBLER
uns/rec--1 photographed at Hobbs 12/27 (JS), 1 at Las Cruces 12/17 (WP+), 2 near Loving 12/30 and 1 near Carlsbad 12/28 (RW+).

NASHVILLE WARBLER
uns/rec--1 at Socorro 4/25 (PB).

OLIVE WARBLER
uns/rec--a male was seen and detailed near Glenwood 12/30 (RSk+).

GRACE WARBLER
con/rec--1 in the Cook's Range 4/23-25 (JH).

BAY-BREASTED WARBLER
uns/rec--4 males reported in detail at Boone's Draw 5/6 (GS+).

COMMON YELLOWTHROAT
con/rec--a male at Las Cruces 12/17 (WB+).

HOODED WARBLER
uns/rec--1 at Alamogordo 5/26 - song taped (J. Stone, fide LM).

YELLOW-HEADED BLACKBIRD
win/rec--1 at Kirtland 2/13 (CS) and 25 at San Simon Cienega 2/4-5 (JH,GS).

SCOTT ORIOLE

uns/rec--for the fourth year a bird wintered near Silver City (RF+); con/rec--1 at El Pueblo 5/29 was the second record for this locality (WH).

GREAT-TAILED GRACKLE

con/rec--apparently breeding again at La Cienaga where 3-5 were seen 4/11,20 (JH), 6+ nests at Pleasaton 5/25 (JH), a male in the Mimbres Valley 4/23 (JH), and 35 birds at Carlisbad 3/1 (JH).

COMMON GRACKLE

con/rec--3-4 at Santa Fe 3/15 and 4/30 (JH).

BRONZED COWBIRD

con/rec--1 at Glenwood 5/29-30 (EE,BB) and a male and 2 females near Rodeo 5/23 (RS).

HEPATIC TANAGER

con/rec--5 at Miller Canyon near Roy 5/19-21 (JH+).

CARDINAL

con/rec--1 at Socorro 4/20 (AT), 1 bird at the Bosque del Apache NWR 1/7,2/25, and 4/22 (JD+), and 1 at Rodeo 1/1 (RS).

PYRRHULOXIA

con/rec--1 at Oasis SP 3/21 (AN), 2 at Roswell 12/17 (JC+), 3 at Caprock 3/21 (AN), and a male at Silver City 4/21 (DM, RM).

CASSIN FINCH

uns/rec--a young bird just able to fly was seen with a pair of adults at Santa Fe 5/22 (JH); common W. of Dulce 5/20-31 (AN).

GRAY-CROWNED ROSY FINCH

con/rec--approximately 250 near Navajo L. 2/20 (AN).

BROWN-CAPPED ROSY FINCH

con/rec--25 N.E. of Farmington 12/23 (GS).

PINE SISKIN

con/rec--several small flocks in the Clovis area 3/19 (AN).

AMERICAN GOLDFINCH

con/rec--at least 2 in Clovis 3/19 (AN) and 37 near Loving 12/30 (SW+).

LAWRENCE GOLDFINCH

uns/rec--4 in the Peloncillo Mountains 1/1 (RS+).

WHITE-WINGED CROSSBILL

uns/rec--1 immature male at Sandia Crest 3/24 (GW).

GREEN-TAILED TOWHEE

win/rec--41 in the Peloncillo Mountains 1/1 (RS+).

LARK SPARROW

uns/rec--3 at the Bosque del Apache NWR 12/28 (CH+) and 6 at Roswell 12/17 (JC+).

LE CONTE SPARROW

uns/rec--1 at Randles Pool 3/4 (KZ); details include "small stub-tailed sparrow, extremely buffy on entire front of bird including face, buffy stripe through center of crown, back streaked, ring of streaks (necklace) around central part of breast.
