FROM THE EDITORS:

This summer members of the New Mexico Department of Game and Fish, Endangered Species Program, carried out blotic surveys in two mountain ranges in the state: The Animas in the extreme southwest and Sierra Grande in the extreme northeast. Emphasis was on endangered and other noteworthy species but when time permitted these surveys were expanded to provide data on other species as well. Reports on both areas are being prepared but ornithological highlights included discovery of White-eared Hummingbirds and a probable Buff-breasted Flycatcher in the Animas in addition to further documentation of peripheral species that inhabit Sierra Grande (e.g. Dusky Flycatcher, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, Mepatic Tanager). Greg Schmitt and Alan Nelson made separate forays into the Chuskas, another interesting and incompletely studied range, while Bill Baltosser studied hummingbirds and other species in Guadalupe Canyon. Other important finds during the period were a Pyrrhuloxia nest at Dog Spring (apparently the first for N.M. west of the Rio Grande) and a Brown-capped Rosy Finch nest near Santa Fe (a first for the state). Summer vagrants included a Yellow-throated Warbler at Tesuque, California Gulls at Eagle Nest Lake, Sulphurbellied Flycatcher near Cliff, and a Thick-billed Kingbird at Dog Spring.

During autumn, surveys which included netting of birds were done at Boone's Draw by the Endangered Species Program and the Daniel McKnights (see N.M.O.S. Bull. 5:(1) 1977). Among the yields were Black-billed Cuckoo, Great Crested, Least, Western, and Yellow-bellied flycatchers; Tennessee, Mourning, and Magnolia Warblers. Trends over the period included minor lowland invasions of Saw-whet Owls, Pygmy Nuthatches. Winter Wrens, and Golden-crowned Kinglets. Sprague Pipits occurred in numbers in November in the Animas Valley; White-tailed Ptarmigan were found twice in the Sangre de Cristo Mountains; and 6 or 7 Whooping Cranes arrived in the state in October and November. Among the more unusual birds were first confirmed records of Common Tern and Varied Thrush plus additional records of White Ibises, Whimbrel, Blue-throated Hummingbird, and Bay-breasted Warbler. Sight records included an incredible American Oystercatcher, two Black-legged Kitiwakes, and a White-winged Crossbill. Other "lesser" vagrants included a Surf Scoter, Hooded Warblers, and Purple Finches in what has been a very good season for birds. Also included here is March 1976 photographic record of a Glaucous Gull, a first state verification that was inadvertently left out of the last report!
