FROM THE EDITORS:

The season's prize was a sub-adult Aplomado Falcon in a restricted area of the White Sands Missile Range. It was seen repeatedly and was photographed by Kevin Martin. The last previous credible report for the state was in December 1978. There is no clue to the origin of the new Aplomado.

Another rarity was a possible Botter¢'s Sparrow in the ⁴ Animas valley; it's still unconfirmed for our state. A possible dark-phase Broad-winged Hawk in the Jemez Mts. was far out of place for this variant, known to breed only in western Canada.

Whiskered Screech Owls were back in the Peloncillo Mts., but one in the Animas Mts. was at a new locale for the species. A banding program in Roosevelt County netted 75 Barn Owls -- including only 8 adults!

Among hummingbirds, a Violet-crowned pair nested in Guadalupe Canyon, Blue-throated were near Jemez Springs and in the Magdalena Mts, and Magnificents were at several southwestern locales. Elegant Trogons calling in the Peloncillo Mts. possibly bred there; one was photographed in the Animas Mts.

Least Terns had bad luck at Bitter L. -- 5 nests but only one offspring. A Least at Bosque NWR was a rarity for the Rio Grande valley. New patterns at Albuquerque: White-winged Doves breeding regularly, and Chihuahuan Ravens are now year-around residents.

Vireos made news: A singing White-eyed on the Magdalenas count; Bell's near Hope and Roswell, northerly for them, and two pairs of Gray Vireos (including a nest) in the Sandias. Meantime, Eastern Bluebirds reared a brood west of Cliff, their first breeding record in western N.M.

WHITE-WINGED DOVE -- Breeding: A pair fledged at least one stub-tailed juvenal again this year in the Albuquerque north valley by 7/10 (still present 8/9)(BO); 23 birds plus active nestsin Guadalupe Canyon 6/6 (SWi).

INCA DOVE -- unusual: Several in Portales (fide Anthony Gennaro; 1 or 2 at Socorro 7/7 (JPa, BP), Truth or Consequences 6/15 (DM), Las Cruces 6/28 (CSa) and Carlsbad 6/5 (SW).

<u>COMMON GROUND DOVE -- 2 seen and calling near Cliff 6/4 (RF), where they are casual.</u>

YELLOW-BILLED CUCKOO -- Widespread in small numbers: 2 each at Clayton (WC) and Bosque NWR (GE); singles near Williamsburg (CSa), on Cooley L. BBS, west of Roswell (SWi) and at Black R. Village (SW). Late arrivals emphasized the wide distribution: 2 each in the Gila Valley (RF), in Guadalupe Canyon and at Redrock (JPa), and along the Black and Pecos Rivers.

<u>GREATER ROADRUNNER</u> -- Singles at unusual locations, at Clayton (WC) and on the Floyd BBS (WU).

BARN OWL -- Only 8 adults, but 67 juveniles banded by James Weaver in southeast Roosevelt County 5/19 to 6/18.

WHISKERED SCREECH OWL -- 1 on 6/4 and pair on 6/30 in canyon n. of Clanton; 1 at Clanton Canyon 7/27 and 7/31 (PSn, DC); first report from Gray Ranch, pair in Animas Mts. 6/23 (JB1, CB).

NORTHERN PYGMY OWL - 1 in Clanton Canyon 7/4 (JPa, BE).

BURROWING OWL -- Breeding: "Nesting sites increased this summer, with at least 8 known in e. and se. Carlsbad; 5 sites were within a 100-meter area" (SW, Bob Click).

<u>SPOTTED OWL -- Breeding</u>: On 7/11 and 7/24 there were 2 adults and 3 immatures near Zuni, "the third time in past four years this pair has fledged 3 young" (DC)....1 heard in Piños Altos Mts. 7/6 (JPa, BP).

LONG-EARED OWL -- Breeding: 1 adult and 3 immatures at Las Vegas NWR 6/16 (Bernard Foy)....5 in Magdalena Mts. 7/15 (JB1, CB).

VIOLET-CROWNED HUMMINGBIRD -- Pair in Guadalupe Canyon, female collecting nesting material, 6/6 (SWi); also 2 or 3 there 7/4 (JPa, BP). BLUE-THROATED HUMMINGBIRD -- unusual: 1 male near Jemez Springs 6/18 (Glenda McGrath); 1 possible female in Six-Mile Canyon, Magdalena Mts., 6/1 (Paul McConnell); 1 male in Mill Canyon, Magdalena Mts., 6/29, 7/15 (JB1, CB). MAGNIFICENT HUMMINGBIRD -- Single males in Magdalena Mts. 6/29 (JBI, CB), and at Alma 7/26-28 (Steve and Barbara Rothman); 2 males at Signal Peak 7/6+ (JPa, RF); 3 at Trout Valley, Grant County, all summer (RF). LUCIFER HUMMINGBIRD -- Single male and female in canyon north of Clanton 6/5, 30 (SWi); 1 female in Peloncillo Mts. 7/5 (JPa); estimated 15 to 20, including fledged immatures, at Post Office Canyon by the end of the period (RS). ANNA'S HUMMINGBIRD -- First arrival at Los Ojos 6/30 (LS) and at Los Alamos 6/29 (PSn). ELEGANT TROGON -- unusual: A probable pair, possibly breeding, were calling repeatedly in the Peloncillo Mts., and 1 male** was in the Animas Mts. 6/24 (JB1, CB). BELTED KINGFISHER -- Breeding: Adult carrying food at a secluded bank near Zuni 7/14 (DC) and assumed to be nesting....3 at Fort Sumner 6/2 (SWi). RED-HEADED WOODPECKER -- 1 at White Sands NM in June (John Manganelli). <u>GILA WOODPECKER -- Breeding</u>: 10, including pair feeding young, in a cavity at Guadalupe Canyon 6/6 (SWi)and 10 there again 7/4 (JPa, BP)....4 at Animas Creek, Gray Ranch, 6/23 (JB1, CB). STRICKLAND'S WOODPECKER -- Breeding: Nest found in Animas Mts. 6/17-24 (JB1, CB). THREE-TOED WOODPECKER -- A female at Jemez Falls 7/13 (JPa). NORTHERN FLICKER -- 1 or 2 yellow-shafted forms in the Clayton area in June and July (WC). NORTHERN BEARDLESS TYRANNULET -- Pair in Guadalupe Canyon 6/5-6 (SWi) and 3 calling there 7/4 (JPa, BP). OLIVE-SIDED FLYCATCHER -- 1 at Fort Bayard 7/17 (RF) was early; singles at Rattlesnake Springs 6/5 (SW) and near Otis 6/16 (SW) were late. GREATER_PEWEE -- A pair at McMillan campground in Pinos Altos Mts. from late April to 7/6 (JPa, BP) WILLOW FLYCATCHER -- Singles singing at Bosque NWR 7/7 (JPa, BP), and at Mangas Springs 6/5 (RF). GRAY FLYCATCHER -- 7 on Pecos BBS (CR), 7 on Magdalena count, 1 singing male on Claunch BBS (SWi), 2 singing males on Carrizozo BBS (SWi), and a singing male near L. Roberts (RF+).

<u>CORDILLERAN FLYCATCHER</u> -- <u>Breeding</u>:Pair with nest at San Cristobal 6/16 (PI+)....3 at Bosque NWR 6/15 (PI, LH), where rare in summer. BLACK PHOEBE -- 1 singing on Pecos BBS (CR) was northerly. EASTERN PHOEBE -- 1 at Las Vegas NWR 7/19 (CSa). <u>VERMILION FLYCATCHER</u> -- <u>Breeding</u>: A female starting to build a nest in Truth or Consequences 7/6 (CSa). BROWN-CRESTED FLYCATCHER -- 2 in Guadalupe Canyon 6/6 (SWi) and 7/4 (JPa, BP), where they were greatly outnumbered by Duskycapped and Ash-throateds. EASTERN KINGBIRD -- 7 at Maxwell NWR 6/22 (JPa), 2 at La Cueva SGR 7/20 (CR, LH), 1 near Watrous 6/28 (RPx, SP), and 1 on Cooley L. BBS 6/2 (SWi). SCISSOR-TAILED FLYCATCHER -- unusual: A juvenile at Moriarty 7/28 (PSt). TREE SWALLOW -- A pair at nest cavity near Los 0jos 6/27 (LS). BANK SWALLOW -- At least 12 burrows still active in Albuquerque 7/13, and young were probably still in them when they were razed by the city 7/17 (HS). GRAY JAY -- 2 on Johnson Mesa 7/21 (CR) at southern limit of range. BLUE JAY -- unusual: 1 at Albuquerque 7/23-24 (BO), the first in 15 months. AMERICAN CROW -- 3 on Grenville BBS 6/16 (KS), and singles at Laguna Huerfana 6/6 (JH) and Ute Creek, Harding County 6/12 (CR) were easterly. CHIHUAHUAN RAVEN - Breeding: 2 of 4 birds fledged from a nest s. of Clayton 6/27 (HS) were northerly; 2 active nests were found 10 to 15 miles southeast of Belen 6/22 (Bill Willard)....Also northerly were 4 west of Sabinoso 6/24 (CR) and 6 near Grenville 6/16 (KS). <u>COMMON RAVEN</u> ____ Two 15 miles south of Clayton 6/27 (HS) were identified by voice. Rather rare there, especially in summer. BLACK-CAPPED CHICKADEE -- 3 on the Valencia BBS 6/2 (HS). BRIDLED TITMOUSE -- 2 on Magdalenas count. PYGMY NUTHATCH -- 1 in JH's yard in Santa Fe 7/7 was a local first ... Very high numbers found near Los Alamos 7/11 (BL). CACTUS WREN -- 1 east of Sabinoso (CR) for third consecutive year; 2 west of Logan 6/12 (CR); 2 on Cerro Verde BBS 6/9 (Greg Farley) were north of range. ROCK WREN -- Breeding: 4 juvenals fledged in residential area of Los Alamos (BL). <u>CAROLINA WREN -- unusual</u>: 1 still singing in Sandia Mts. 6/7 (HS); there since April. AMERICAN DIPPER -- 1 in Rio Grande Gorge (Big Arsenic Spring Trail) 7/29 (CSa). GOLDEN-CROWNED KINGLET -- Fairly common in Sandia Mts. (HS); 1 on Magdalenas count; 16 on Cloudcroft BBS 6/25 (CR, LH). RUBY-CROWNED KINGLET -- 2 on Magdalenas count; 4 on Cloudcroft

BBS 6/25 (CR, LH).

BLUE-GRAY GNATCATCHER -- 12 on Magdalena count. BLACK-TAILED GNATCATCHER -- 1 n. of Lordsburg 7/5 (JPa, BP). EASTERN BLUEBIRD -- Breeding: Pair of adults with 2 fledged young and others in nest w. of Cliff 6/3-4 (RF, found by SM, photo by DZ) was the first breeding record for western New Mexico. VEERY -- Singing male w. of Vadito 6/28 (JRT), where 1 or 2 have been reported regularly in recent years. GRAY CATBIRD -- 1 along the Gallinas R. w. of Gallinas 7/20 (CR), in appropriate breeding habitat. SAGE THRASHER -- 20 on Torreon BBS 6/7 (CR). BROWN THRASHER -- 1 at Fort Union 6/23 (RPx, SP), suggestive of local breeding. BENDIRE'S THRASHER -- 1 in Los Alamos 7/2 (BF); 1 on Valencia BBS 6/2 (HS); 3 on Torreon BBS 6/7 (CR); 1 at Gray Ranch 6/7 (SWi). CRISSAL THRASHER -- 1 on Albuquerque's west mesa 7/28 follows a sighting near there in May; above-average numbers in Las Cruces area (CSa). AMERICAN PIPIT -- 1 on Magdalena count; 1 at Bosque NWR 6/6 (BZ) was very late and apparently injured, as it was still there limping 6/14 (PSn, Joyce Takamine). CEDAR WAXWING -- 1 at Santa Fe 7/14 (LH). PHAINOPEPLA -- 1 male at Socorro 6/18 (CR); 2 from San Antonio to Socorro 7/27 (JPa); 59 on canoe trip from Truth or Conse-quences to Caballo L. 7/6 (CSa); 2 near Sitting Bull Falls 6/14 (Bobby Click, Tommy Hines); 42 in Guadalupe Canyon 6/5-6 (SWi). WHITE-EYED VIREO -- 1 singing and seen well in Six-Mile Canyon on Magdalena count. BELL'S VIREO -- 2 males on Rio Felix w. of Roswell 6/10 (SWi) were farther north than usual; 3 at Rattlesnake Springs 6/5 (SW); 1 singing in Four-mile Draw s. of Hope 6/9 was a new area record (SW). GRAY VIREO -- Breeding: 2 pairs on north side of Sandias with a nest containing 3 young found 8/1 (HS); 2 pairs plus 3 sing-ing males in Big Canyon, Guadalupe Mts., 6/18 (SWi). SOLITARY VIREO -- 2 in Trujillo Canyon 6/6 (JH); 52 on Magdalena count. HUTTON'S VIREO -- Breeding: Pair with 2 fledglings on Little Cherry Greek 7/22 (RF)....2 in Peloncillo Mts. 6/4 (SWi) and 7/4-5 (JPa, BP). WARBLING VIREO -- 39 on Cloudcroft BBS 6/25 (CR, LH); 42 on Magdalena count. ORANGE-CROWNED WARBLER -- 1 in Jemez Mts. 7/16 (PSn); 9 on Cloudcroft BBS 6/25 (CR, LH). VIRGINIA'S WARBLER -- 1 in Trujillo Canyon 6/6 (JH); 1 in Pelon-cillo Mts. 6/5 (SWi); 34 on Magdalena count.

NORTHERN PARULA -- 1 in Roswell 6/1 (SB).

BLACK-THROATED GRAY WARBLER --- Breeding: Pair with fledglings on Little Cherry Creek 7/22 (RF)....12 on Magdalena count; 1 in Peloncello Mts. 6/5 (SWi).

<u>GRACE'S WARBLER</u> -- <u>Breeding</u>: Seen feeding young in the Pinos Altos Mts. 7/22 (RF)....26 on Magdalena count; 1 singing in the Turkey Mts. 6/25 (RPx, SP).

COMMON YELLOWTHROAT -- Numbers down at Mangas Springs (RF).

<u>WILSON'S WARBLER</u> -- 1 in Santa Fe 6/2 (JH); 10 on Magdalena count were late migrants.

<u>RED-FACED WARBLER</u> -- 12 on Magdalena count; "common in all canyons" (RF); feeding young in Spring Canyon 7/13 and on Little Cherry Creek 7/20 (RF).

PAINTED REDSTART -- Breeding: Adult feeding fledgling in McMillan Canyon 6/23 (RF).

YELLOW-BREASTED CHAT -- Reported almost statewide; 15 along 5 miles of the Rio Grande on a canoe trip below Truth or Consequences 7/6 (CSa).

OLIVE WARBLER -- Breeding: Female feeding a fledgling in Spring Canyon 7/20 and male feeding a fledgling in Little Cherry Creek Canyon 7/22 (RF)....A male at Signal Peak 6/21,25 (RF); 3 there 7/6 were apparently a family group (JPa, BP).

HEPATIC TANAGER -- 1 at Las Vegas NWR 7/18 (CR).

WESTERN TANAGER -- Several in Animas Mts. in mid-June (JB1, CB) were at the southern edge of breeding range.

NORTHERN CARDINAL -- A male on Roswell BBS (SWi) for second consecutive year.

INDIGO BUNTING -- Pairs in Corrales bosque 6/24 (TB) and in Peloncillo Mts. 7/17 (GE+).

VARIED BUNTING -- 3 males in Guadalupe Canyon 6/6 (SWi) and a possible juvenile with a female there 7/4 (JPa, BP).

DICKCISSEL -- Single singing males at Maxwell NWR 6/22 (JPa) and 7/21, and on Cooley L. BBS (SWi). None at Fort Union (RPx, SP), where they have been in previous, years.

BOTTERI'S SPARROW -- unusual: A possible flushed from sacaton grasses in Animas Valley 6/7 (SWi); the species remains unconfirmed in New Mexico.

<u>CASSIN'S SPARROW</u> -- <u>Breeding</u>: Widespread and numerous in the east, including a nest in Union County with 4 eggs 6/27 (HS). ...12+ singing males at Fort Union 6/15-28 (RPx, SP) were westerly, 16 at Sevilleta NWR 6/9 (PB, RT); 5 in Animas Valley, and some on Valencia, Rodeo and Cloverdale BBS's.

<u>RUFOUS-CROWNED SPARROW</u> - 2 singing males and 1 female at Las Vegas NWR 7/18 (CR) were at a new locality for the species.

BLACK-CHINNED SPARROW -- 2 singing in Trujillo Canyon 6/6 (JH), 1 singing male on Claunch BBS (SWi), and 4 on Carrizozo BBS (SWi). BLACK-THROATED SPARROW -- Unusual: 2 at Lamy 6/4 (CR).

SAGE SPARROW -- unusual: 8 at Sevilleta NWR 6/6 (PB, RT); 33 on Torreon BBS (CR).

LARK BUNTING -- 23 on Grenville BBS (KS) and 21 s. of Wagon Mound 7/20 (CR, LH). Various single males from Maxwell NWR 6/22 (JPa) to Las Vegas area 6/11 (CR), and 12 late migrants on Magdalenas count.

SAVANNAH SPARROW -- 10 singing at Maxwell NWR 6/22 (JPa).

<u>GRASSHOPPER SPARROW</u> -- Relatively plentiful in northeast, including 25 at Maxwell NWR 6/22 (JPa), fair numbers near Clayton in June (HS, WC), and 6 at Las Vegas NWR 7/25 (CR). In southwest, high of 37 on Cloverdale BBS (SWi).

SONG SPARROW -- Singles at Zuni 7/23 (DC) and Las Vegas NWR 7/19, 25 (CR); 9 near Gallinas e. of Las Vegas 7/20 (CR).

LINCOLN'S SPARROW -- 2 on Cloudcroft BBS (CR) added to evidence of possible local breeding there.

WHITE-CROWNED SPARROW -- Singles on Valencia BBS (HS), at Bosque NWR 6/16 (JPa) and in Animas Valley 6/23 (JB1, CB) were very late.

YELLOW-EYED JUNCO -- Juvenile in Animas Mts. mid-June (JB1, CB).

EASTERN MEADOWLARK - 5 singing s. of Clayton 6/27 (HS), 5 singing near Lamy 6/4, 11 (CR), and 22 on Cerro Verde BBS (Greg Farley).

<u>BRONZED COWBIRD</u> -- 3 at Glenwood 7/28-29 (JH), a male at Truth or Consequences in June and July (DM), and a pair at Las Cruces in June and July (GE) were northerly.

PINE GROSBEAK -- Singing male and 2 others in mountains w. of Las Vegas 7/21 (CR).

<u>CASSIN'S FINCH</u> -- Outside the Jemez Mts.: 1 at Chama 6/26 (LS), 5 n. of Mineral Hill 7/13 (CR), and up to 5 at Capulin Spring in Sandia Mts. all summer.

<u>RED CROSSBILL</u> -- In smaller mountain ranges: 6 in Sandias 6/2-4 (PSt), 13 on Magdalenas count, 5 on Cloudcroft BBS (CR, LH), and several in mid-June in Animas (JB1, CB).

<u>PINE SISKIN</u> -- 1 at Bosque NWR 7/27 (JPa) and several at Pleasancon July 27-30 (JH) were early.

AMERICAN GOLDFINCH -- unusual: Singles at Deer Creek, Animas Mts., 6/18-19 (JB1, CB) and at Zuni 7/15 (DC)....Seen June through July near Chama (LS).

<u>EVENING GROSBEAK</u> -- 1 at Santa Fe 6/8 (JH) was late. A pair plus one female at Capulin Springs in Sandias 6/20 and one female there 7/9 (PSt). 4 on Claunch BBS (SWi).
