RECENT REVISIONS TO THE AOU CHECK-LIST AFFECTING NEW MEXICO BIRDS

INTRODUCTION

The recently-published "41st Supplement" to the American Ornithologists' Union (AOU) *Checklist of North American Birds (Auk* 114[3]: 542-552, 1997) contained numerous taxonomic and nomenclatural changes adopted recently by the AOU "Check-list Committee." The supplement, the seventh since the publication of the 6th edition of the AOU *Check-list* in 1983, is intended to be the last prior to publication of the 7th edition. As such, the supplement both affects the current 6th edition and announces changes that will be incorporated in the forthcoming 7th edition.

Most of the changes relate to sequence or rank of various taxonomic categories, these generally based on published DNA-DNA hybridization studies. Some of these (e.g., placing the vultures with the storks, moving the shrikes and vireos to a position near the tyrant flycatchers, etc.) may appear radical to persons long used to the current sequence of bird families; however, many of these have been long anticipated, and the literature supporting such moves is generally convincing.

Below is a summary of these changes as they affect the New Mexico list, which includes the addition of two new vireo species. Readers are encouraged to seek out and read the full 11-page supplement --as well as the nearly 100 references cited therein--so they may better understand the evidence and reasoning behind these decisions.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Patronymic English names that end in "s" are now rendered in the possessive "s's," hence on the New Mexico list we have Ross's Goose, Harris's Hawk, Lewis's Woodpecker, and Harris's Sparrow.

The family Cathartidae (American vultures) is removed from the order Falconiformes and inserted into the suborder Ciconiae (storks), following the family Ciconiidae.

The classification and especially the sequence of the Anatidae (ducks, geese, and swans) are rather extensively altered, based on a series of published studies. The sequence of the whistling-duck species is changed, the swans now follow the geese, and there are numerous sequence changes within the several genera of geese and ducks. The Masked Duck (hypothetical in New Mexico) is placed in a new genus, becoming *Nomonyx dominicus*, and preceeds the Ruddy Duck in sequence.

The Gray Hawk is removed from the genus *Buteo*, becoming *Asturina nitida*, and is placed with other subbuteonines; on the New Mexico list, this places the Gray Hawk after the Northern Goshawk and before the Common Black-Hawk.

Within the family Phasianidae, the sequence of genera in the subfamily Tetraoninae (grouse) is reordered to become (on the New Mexico list) *Centrocercus, Dendragapus, Lagopus,* and *Tympanuchus*. These grouse follow the introduced Ring-necked Pheasant and precede the Wild Turkey.

The New World quail are raised to the level of family: Odontophoridae. On the New Mexico list, this new family follows Phasianidae.

The specific name for the American Golden-Plover is (once again) corrected, to *Pluvialis dominica;* this corrects a grammatical error in the 40th Supplement.

The genus of the Burrowing Owl reverts from Speotyto to Athene.

The scientific name of the Olive-sided Flycatcher is changed from *Contopus borealis* to C. *cooperi;* this because of priority.

The large suborder Passeres (oscines) will, on the New Mexico list, begin with the families Laniidae (shrikes), Vireonidae (vireos), and Corvidae (jays and crows). These follow the family Tyrannidae (tryant flycatchers). The hypothetical (in New Mexico) Rose-throated Becard, *Pachyramphus aglaiae*, would be inserted uncertainly (*"incertae sedis"*) between the flycatchers and shrikes.

Within the vireos, the former Solitary Vireo is divided into three species, all of which are verified as occurring in New Mexico: Blue-headed Vireo, *Vireo solitarius*, a very rare spring and fall migrant primarily to eastern New Mexico; Cassin's Vireo, *V. cassinii*, an uncommon but widespread (including east to the Texas line) migrant and occasional winterer; and Plumbeous Vireo, *V. plumbeus*, the fairly common, widespread and familiar breeding species of New Mexico's mountainous areas, common throughout in migration and occasional in the south in winter.

Following the family Corvidae, the families from Alaudidae (larks) through Cinclidae (dippers) follow in the same sequence as in the 6^{th} edition.

Within the family Hirundinidae, the genus *Petrochelidon* (Cliff and Cave swallows) is separated from, and follows, *Hirundo* (Barn Swallow).

Within the family Paridae, the genus *Parus* is divided into several genera, two of which (*Poecile* for chickadees and *Baeolophus* for titmice) are used for species in New Mexico. Furthermore, the former Plain Titmouse is divided into two species, Oak Titmouse, *Baeolophus inornatus*, and Juniper Titmouse, *B. ridgwayi;* the Juniper Titmouse is the species residing in New Mexico. The sequence for the five parids verified in New Mexico becomes Black-capped, Mountain, and Mexican chickadees followed by Bridled and Juniper titmice.

Following the dippers, the current subfamilies of the large family Muscicapidae are returned to their former rank as families, while the kinglets are raised to the level of family Regulidae and preceed the family Sylviidae, hence on the New Mexico list the sequence becomes Regulidae (kinglets), Sylviidae (gnatcatchers) and Turdidae (bluebirds, solitaires, and thrushes), these followed by the family Mimidae (mockingbirds and thrashers).

The family Sturnidae (starlings) is moved to a position following the Mimidae and is followed, in order, by Motacillidae, Bombycillidae, and Ptilogonatidae.

Following the family Ptilogonatidae (phainopeplas), the current subfamilies of the large family Emberizidae are returned to their former rank as families. Additionally, the Olive Warbler, *Peucedramus taeniatus*, traditionally placed at the end of the Parulidae, becomes the basis of a monotypic family, Peucedramidae, which is placed ahead of the Parulidae.

The subfamily Cardinalinae becomes the family Cardinalidae (*Cardinalis, Pheucticus* and Blue grosbeaks, *Passerina* buntings, and Dickcissel) and is moved to a position following Emberizidae (towhees, sparrows, and longspurs). The hypothetical (in New Mexico) White-collared Seedeater is moved to a position at the beginning of the Emberizidae.


The new sequence for the four species of *Zonotrichia* sparrows in New Mexico becomes White-throated, Harris's, White-crowned, and Golden-crowned.

Within the family Icteridae, the new sequence for our two species of *Quiscalus* grackles becomes Common Grackle followed by Great-tailed Grackle.

CHECKLIST OF NEW MEXICO BIRD SPECIES

<u>Verified Species</u>.--The following list treats 530 species of birds, of which 493 species are definitely known to occur (or have occurred) within the state of New Mexico during the historic (1540 to present) period. These 493 verified species, including four successfully established non-native species, are those whose occurrence in New Mexico has been and can be verified by reference to specimens, photographs, or voice recordings of unquestioned provenance. This list of verified species reflects the decisions of the New Mexico Bird Records Committee through the Spring of 1997, with the addition of 2 species subsequently verified but as yet not circulated to the committee.

<u>Hypothetical Species</u>.--Also listed are 37 additional species that have been reported but either have not been verified or, if verified, are not known to represent naturally occurring individuals or successfully established populations. These hypothetical (in New Mexico) species are placed within brackets and include reports of varying quality. This is not an exhaustive listing of all such hypothetical species reported over the years-notably absent are the several failed gamebird introductions (although the apparently-failed Chukar is included owing to continued releases) as well as the numerous escaped cagebird and other exotic species

that have been recorded in the state. Whether verified or hypothetical, the few non-native species listed herein are indicated by the code "1" ("introduced").

<u>Breeding Species</u>.-- This list also identifies 298 species that breed (or bred) or that probably breed (or bred) in New Mexico. Proof of breeding rests on documentation of nests, eggs, nestlings, and/or dependant juveniles. "Courtship" behavior and presence in suitable habitat during the breeding season, while highly suggestive, do not prove local breeding. By these criteria, 285 species definitely breed (or bred) and 13 species probably do (or did) so. The 298 breeding species are divided into 8 categories, which are defined as follows (with the number of species in each included):

<u>Taxonomy</u>.--The nomenclature and sequence of families and species follow the Sixth Edition of the AOU *Check-list of North American Birds* (1983) as amended through the 41st Supplement (July 1997), but including announced changes that will be incorporated in the forthcoming Seventh Edition of the AOU *Check-list*.

<u>Acknowledgments</u>.-- This New Mexico species list reflects the cooperative efforts of the many members of the New Mexico Ornithological Society (NMOS) and others interested in birds and ornithology in New Mexico. It is built upon previous New Mexico avifaunal compendia (Bailey 1928, Ligon 1961, Hubbard 1970 & 1978) and other appropriate (and especially subsequent) publications, including *American Birds/Audubon Field Notes* and *NMOS Field Notes*, plus unpublished archival and specimen materials known to the NMOS, the New Mexico Bird Records Committee, and/or the New Mexico Department of Game and Fish. Those persons with information on the occurrence or breeding status of New Mexico birds that is not reflected in this list, and those with suggestions or other comments regarding the list, are encouraged to contact the author.
