The evening program was "On Safari in East Africa,' by Donna Cole Schmitt and Steve Zack.

Registering for the 11 April meeting were 45 people, which was a good turnout.

The Sunday field trip was to Candelaria Farms, where Chuck Hundertmark demonstrated the use of mistnets for capturing birds and the techniques of bird-banding.

Dolf Krehbiel, supported by information gathered by him, Wes Cook, and others, is writing a column in the <u>Union County Leader</u> (Clayton, New Mexico). Titled "Union County Birds," the columns have treated subjects such as the status of American Robins in the Clayton area and how to distinguish Canada Geese and Sandhill Cranes. More people should do this sort of thing, as there is a great deal of interest in birds among people who never join societies such as N.M.O.S.
